

Customer information about the use of PFAS in our company

(Per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances)



We would like to inform you about the current status regarding upcoming restrictions on per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS).

Gebrüder Heyl Analysentechnik GmbH & Co. KG exclusively sells non-food products (measuring and control devices as well as chemicals for water analysis). Our packaging is used exclusively for transport and delivery. These technical products do not come into contact with food. Therefore, our products and their packaging are not subject to the specific PFAS regulations for food packaging in Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste.

There is currently no further PFAS regulation or directive.

At the same time, ECHA is continuing to work on the very comprehensive restriction of the entire PFAS group under the REACH Regulation. The opinions of the relevant committees (RAC/SEAC) and thus also the final decision of the EU Commission are delayed; final statements are expected towards the end of 2025, and the actual entry into force of the REACH PFAS restriction is currently expected from 2026 onwards.

Looking ahead, we can inform you that no substances from the PFAS substance class are used in our chemical products.

The packaging and printed materials we use do not contain PFAS.

As we do not yet have any information on limit values or bans for individual substances, we must wait for the final regulation from the ECHA before we can issue a statement on our Testomat series measuring devices. We will continue to monitor developments regarding the future regulation of limit values for PFAS and issue a manufacturer's statement once the regulation has come into force.
