



Conformity Declaration

EU regulation on packaging and packaging waste

Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR) sets out requirements for packaging and packaging waste to ensure recyclability, thereby providing an important foundation for sustainable economic activity.

We, as a manufacturer of water analysis equipment, hereby confirm that all packaging used by us, as well as the products packaged therein, comply with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR) and the relevant provisions of the Packaging Law Implementation Act.

Furthermore, all requirements regarding substance restrictions, particularly with regard to heavy metals and PFAS, are met.

- **Limit value for heavy metals** (total of Pb, Cd, Hg, Cr(VI)) – ≤ 100 mg/kg (100 ppn) in packaging and packaging components.
- **Prohibition on the deliberate addition of PFAS to packaging** – PFAS must not be used in plastic components, either deliberately or inadvertently.

Similarly, the packaging used complies with the applicable guidelines on recyclability, the resource-efficient use of materials and the minimisation of packaging.

Indicator and reagent bottles are not intended for reuse. Please refer to the safety data sheets for the reagents and dispose of the empty bottles accordingly.

Furthermore, all statutory labelling, information and reporting requirements are duly complied with.

We observe all the provisions of the EU Packaging Regulation 2025/40 that are relevant to us and implement them in full in accordance with our current understanding. Where compliance with these provisions depends on the nature or declaration of the intermediate products and materials we source, we rely on the information and declarations of conformity provided by our suppliers. It is not always possible for us to carry out our own additional checks on all intermediate products.
